Dear Parent/Carer,

During Year 11 we seek to ensure every student is able to make the most of all the opportunities that are on offer to prepare for their final examinations.

As we have done in previous years we will be running Year 11 lessons during the period 6 slot on a Wednesday afternoon. To begin with these sessions will be maths focused and alternate between practice test papers and specific revision sessions based on areas of weakness.

The sessions will run from 2-3pm and will be run by the math's team. They will be compulsory through until December and reviewed in the New Year based on the academic progress that students have made.

Over the last two years these types of additional and specific sessions have been a major part of the improvements in exam results. Students have been clear that they have been increasingly confident in their examinations but also in how to best structure their revision time.
